- VII. **OLD BUSINESS**
 - A. **Bike Trail Project- Mapping Updates by Joen Klein:** Presented a map (Titled: Tohatchi Trails-Priority Zones-Trail Feasibility Study) that indicated the location of the bike trails in Tohatchi. Joey explained that the map illustrates 18-20 miles of proposed/existing trails and routes for conceptual shared-use, non-motorized trail network for Tohatchi Chapter. Joey explained the trail project development life cycle timeline and provided background on IMBA and IMBA's focus as an organization. Joey explained the support from Silver Stallion and how Silver Stallion is working with Tohatchi schools. Joey explained that trail concept planning includes local residence input, and this will begin the planning process of a trail identified. Joey explained the trail stages which are identified in colors. Scott Nydum explained how Tohatchi schools can compete at a NM Interscholastic level through school bike clubs. Joey explained a Tohatchi conceptual Bicycle Playgrounds, which is Tohatchi Nahkai Park. This could include a tot track. Joey explained that a NM Recreation is interested in Tohatchi's project, his interest is in finding funding.
